### Diploma Seals/Certificates Available with Diplomas

Several diploma seals and certificates are available to graduates with their diplomas. Following are brief descriptions of each recognition. More information can be found on the Va. Dept. of Education website ([www.doe.virginia.gov](http://www.doe.virginia.gov) or with the Counseling Office).

1. Board of Education Seal - meet requirements for the standard or advanced diploma with a cumulative A average.
2. Governor's Seal - meet requirements for the advanced diploma with a cumulative B average and complete at least nine transferable college credits.
3. Board of Education Career and Technical Seal - meet requirements for the standard or advanced diploma and prescribed Career and Technical Education (CTE) requirements.
4. Board of Education Seal of Advanced Mathematics and Technology - meet requirements for the standard or advanced diploma and prescribed math and CTE requirements.
5. Board of Education Diploma Seal for Excellence in Civics Education - meet requirements for the standard or advanced diploma and prescribed social studies and civic work requirements.
6. Early College Scholars Certificate - meet requirements for the advanced diploma, have a cumulative B average, and complete at least 15 transferable college credits.
7. Seal of Biliteracy – meet requirements for a standard or advanced diploma, and show proficiency in a language other than English, such as scoring a 3 or better on an AP Foreign Language examination.
