Senior Portraits

If you were promoted to 12th grade, be prepared for Senior Portraits! **Students and parents are to schedule portrait sittings over the summer with a photographer of their choice.** In order for your Senior picture to be placed in the yearbook and the Daily News Record,

YOU MUST DO THE FOLLOWING:

- If you chose a photographer ***other than Gentry Photography***, your photographer needs the proper specifications in order for your pictures to print in the best quality format for the yearbook and newspaper. Please note the specifics below:

PHOTO SPECS for formal senior yearbook photos:

- 300 or higher resolution digital photo, 2" x 3".
- Only standard studio backgrounds are accepted.
- Head shot, no props are allowed.
- A drape, tux or cap & gown must be worn: **NO EXCEPTIONS** (Indoors, head shots only).
- The face should be fully visible, so avoid over the shoulder poses or poses with the chin resting on your hand.
- JPEG format, named format should be "LastName, FirstName.jpg"

Submit a digital copy via email of the formal pose to the yearbook sponsor by October 1, 2015. A digital copy may be submitted to: cbentley@rockingham.k12.va.us

- If you are not able to accomplish this over the summer, there will be **limited** make-up times offered in early September here at BHS, through Gentry Photography.
- If the September make-up option is chosen, it is the students' responsibility to come to the main office to sign up for an appointment on a first come, first serve basis. Reminders will also be announced on Morning Student Announcements. **NO PURCHASE OF PHOTOS IS NECESSARY IF TAKEN BY GENTRY PHOTOGRAPHY.**
- **YOU** must check with the yearbook advisor in September to insure that your pictures have been received in the proper format in order to meet the October deadline for yearbook and the DNR.

The BHS yearbook advisor cannot be held responsible for companies failing to send portraits or sending incorrect portraits.

COUNSELING CENTER NEWS – 4th Nine Weeks

Students planning to graduate next year, who will be in night school or Dayton Learning Center – if you will be finishing your classes before the end of the year, please check in with the Counseling Office or Mrs. Martz in order for us to get contact information for senior events, graduation, etc.

SUMMER SCHEDULE CHANGES

Students desiring a schedule change during the summer must submit the request with parent signature of approval by June 26th. After that deadline we can not guarantee that changes can be made except for errors or incorrect placement. After school begins and students have met in each class once, a schedule change request may be given to the counselor.

Students who make a C or below or fail the SOL in their Algebra I or Algebra I Pt II will be double-blocked in Geometry class. However, if a student in an Alg I or Alg I, Pt II class makes an A or B and passes the SOL, he/she can choose to single-block or double-block their next math class. If a student qualifies for a change, the parent will need to contact the counseling office with this request by June 30.

Rockingham County Summer School

Where: East Rockingham High School
Dates: June 15 – July 8 - Repeat classes
June 15 – July 29 - Students who will graduate July 2015, are enrolled in PE 9 or Economics & Personal Finance – July 3rd is a holiday.
Hours: 8:00 am – 12:45 pm for repeat courses
1:15 pm – 3:15 pm for student who will graduate in July 2015 and taking a second class
Fees: 1st Course \$100, Classroom Driver's Education \$30, Online Economics & Personal Finance \$50, Classroom Economics & Personal Finance \$100.
Attendance: No credit will be issued to a student missing over two days (for repeat courses). Seniors and students attending the full summer school session (June 15 – July 29) cannot miss more than five(5) days. **NO** class time can be missed for classroom driver's education.

Exceptions to Summer School Fees:

- 1) Students assigned to summer school by School Board, Superintendent's Discipline Committee, etc.
- 2) Students who started a packet in the Spring and would finish up in Summer School.
- 3) SOL Test Prep students.
 - Seniors may take two new courses if that completes graduation requirements.
 - A graduation ceremony will be held **July 29th at 7:00 pm** at Broadway High School. Graduates will wear the traditional cap/gown of their school.

Applications for summer school are available in the counseling office.

SOL TESTS

SOL tests will be offered to all summer school students who are enrolled in an SOL test class and who have not passed the SOL test during previous testing sessions. Registration is required for all summer testing and for the test prep classes. To schedule an SOL Test, call ERHS, 289-7450, between June 15th and July 1st to register for the test. To schedule a test prep session, call BHS at 896-7081.

ENGLISH 11 WRITING SOL TEST DATES - July 10 & 13

ENGLISH 11 READING SOL TEST PREP DATES – July 6

ALL SOL TEST PREP CLASS DATES (non-writing) – July 6 – 7

END OF YEAR SOL TEST DATES (non-writing) - July 8 - 9

ENGLISH 11 WRITING TEST DATES – July 14 – 15 (must attend both days); 2nd attempt Writing test dates are July 16 - 17

Students not enrolled in one of these classes for the summer session, but who still want to retest in an SOL test area may take the SOL Test Prep class prior to the testing date. All of these test prep classes will be held from 8:00 am - 12:45 pm.

Test PREP sessions will take place at Broadway High School. There is no charge for SOL test prep sessions. All testing will take place at East Rockingham High School. There will be bus transportation FROM BHS that will leave at 7:00 a.m. and return at 1:40 p.m. More information on SOL test prep and tests are in the counseling office.
